

**Just one month to go before this year's Writtle Jazz Festival, 27th - 29th July!**

This year the Festival on Sunday 29th July is preceded by two evenings of Jazz on Friday 27th July and Saturday 28th July, both with exceptional lineups!

On Friday 27th July we kick off at 7.00pm with The Nicola Farnon Trio, returning by popular demand from last year. At 8.15pm Jazz Pianist Jason Rebello, who toured with Sting for many years, is accompanied by the one of the finest Saxophonists in the country, Tim Garland. We conclude the evening with Tony Gooderham's "LivenUp" featuring Roger Curphey on Bass, Paul Higgs on trumpet, Crissy Lee on drums and Laura Jepp on vocals.

Saturday 28th July provides something extraordinary for the guitar lovers! We commence at 7.00pm with The Simon Hurley Quartet. The Daniel Parker trio follows this, with his current project focusing on his own compositions which fuse the sounds of highlife, afrobeat and Cuban music. The headline act is The Fellowship, featuring Zak Barrett on Saxophone, Pete Riley on drums, Seth Govan on bass, John Dutton on keys and the internationally acclaimed Guthrie Govan on guitar!

Sunday provides a plethora of talent across five venues! The Rose and Crown, The Wheatsheaf, The Bridge Street Lounge and Grill, The Writtle Village Hall and The Marquee on the Village green.

We welcome several new bands to the Festival including The Old Jelly Rollers, Miss Rosie & The Moonshyne Runners and James Maltby amongst others and returning from last year, there will be many favourites including our headline in the Marquee, Harry Funk, also the Melvin Beddow Big Band in the Village Hall and Joe Gibson in The Bridge Street Lounge and Grill!
