

# Writtle Writtle Archives Archives

Writtle Archives were initiated in 1990 by the Parish Council to collect and preserve information about the village. The collection consists of hundreds of old photographs of places, events and people, old parish magazines, and newspaper cuttings. Transcriptions have been made of Parish Registers from 1634 to the present, as well as all the census enumerators books of the nineteenth and early twentieth century. The Monumental Inscriptions in the churchyard and inside the church have also been recorded.

The Archives are open every **Wednesday** afternoon in the Christian Centre from 2.00-5.00pm or by arrangement for your own research. If you are unable to come in person searches can be made in our records for family surnames for a small donation to our funds. Local history walks can be arranged for groups around historic Writtle Green, and illustrated talks on a variety of local history subjects can also be arranged.
